Create an Account

Go to DCHealthLink.com and create an account user name and password.

Determine Eligibility

Provide information about you and members of your household to determine your eligibility for private health insurance or Medicaid, and for help with paying for private health insurance. Based on the information you provide, you and your household members could qualify for one of three (3) options:



- Affordable private health insurance
- Private Insurance premium reduction
- Medicaid

Shop and Compare

Make side-by-side comparison of premiums, deductibles and copayments. Use the DC Health Link Doctor Directory to select a doctor and search for the plans in which your doctor(s) participates. Use the DC Health Link Plan Match to find the best plans for your budget and medical needs. Both tools can be found at www.DCHealthLink.com.

Choose a Plan

Select a medical and dental insurance plan. An invoice will be sent to you directly from your insurance company for you to make your first premium payment.

Enroll and Pay

Enrollment is complete once you have made your first payment. Be sure to pay your premiums to your insurance company by the due date each month. Failure to pay on time may result in cancellation of your plan and you may not be able to re-enroll until the next open enrollment period.

Information You Need to Complete a DC Health Link Application

Affordable Private Health Insurance (without premium reductions)

Gather information for everyone in the household to be covered.

Basic Information

- First Name
- Last Name
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Address (if not homeless)
- Social Security Number (for those who have one)

FOR THOSE APPLYING FOR COVERAGE

Official Information

- Citizenship
 - Whether or not household members are U.S. citizens or naturalized citizens
 - If you are unsure about your eligibility due to your immigration status, you can find a list of eligible immigration statuses in the “Forms” section located at www.dchealthlink.com/forms. You will also need immigration document details for anyone with an eligible immigration status.

Private Health Insurance with Premium Reduction or Medicaid

Gather the information for everyone in the household (even those not applying for coverage)

Basic Information

- First Name
- Last Name
- Date of Birth
- Gender
- Address (if not homeless)
- Social Security Number (for those who have one)

Income Information

- Types of income (for example, wages and salaries, Social Security benefits, etc.)
- Amounts of income and how often the person receives it
- Approximate date the person started receiving each type of income
- The total amount of income your household expects to receive this year

Adjustments to Income

- Types of adjustments (These are the adjustments to income you can take on your taxes. For example, student loan interest paid, IRA deduction, etc.)
- Amount of adjustments taken each year
- The approximate date the person started taking this adjustment

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
